Construction Cap. 196

**12.** This Part shall be read as one with the Export Tax Ordinance.

New section IA. added to Cap. 196 **13.** The Export Tax Ordinance is amended by adding, immediately below section I the following section:-

"Interpretation 1A. In this Ordinance "Minister" means the Minister for the time being responsible for finance.".

Amendment to proviso to section 2 Cap. 196 **14.** The Export Tax Ordinance is amended in section 2, in the proviso, by deleting the words "for the time being responsible for financial matters" which occur immediately after the words "the Minister" in the second line of the said proviso.

General amendments Cap. 196

- 15. The Export Tax Ordinance is amended-
- (a) by deleting all references to the President (or, as previously appearing, Governor in Council or Governor) wheresoever they occur therein, and substituting therefor in each case reference to the Minister;
- (b) by deleting all references to the Legislative Council wheresoever they occur therein and substituting therefor in each case reference to the National Assembly;
- (c) in section 3, by deleting subsection (5);
- (d) in section 5-
  - (i) in subsection (1) by deleting paragraphs (b) and (c);

  - (iii) by renumbering subsection (3) as subsection (2).

(2) The Minister may, by order in the *Gazette*, amend the First Schedule by deleting therefrom any item and where such item is so deleted the entertainment to which the item relates shall, with effect from the date on which such order comes into operation, cease to be a scheduled entertainment'.

Contracts relating to development projects **22A.** Where for the purpose of any development project which has been approved by the National Assembly by resolution or otherwise any contract for the supply of goods or services is entered into on behalf of the United Republic which provides that any payment (other than payment charged on the Consolidated Fund) is to be made on or after the first day of July next following, the Minister shall as soon as possible after the making of such contract give notice thereof to the National Assembly and every such notice shall specify-

(i) the names of the contracting parties;

- (ii) the nature of the goods or services to be supplied;
- (iii) the total amount payable by the United Republic in respect of such goods or services and the date or dates on which payment it is to be made;

(iv) the development project to which such contract is referable."
